

ROCKRIDGE PARK

BEND, OREGON

ROCKRIDGE is a 36 acre community park that blends a native Central Oregon juniper forest landscape with recreational amenities catered to the active lifestyle of its residents. Master planning by Cameron McCarthy defined park features, activities, and character to achieve a harmonious relationship with the neighborhood. 60% of the site was retained as natural area, while trees and stones in impacted areas were salvaged and integrated into the new design. Designed and implemented features include a system of paved and natural running/walking trails; youth/beginner mountain biking skills course; nature play area; traditional play area; lunar-scape skate park; a disc putting course; and a large flexible open space with adjacent picnic tables and large shelter. The park was opened in 2017.

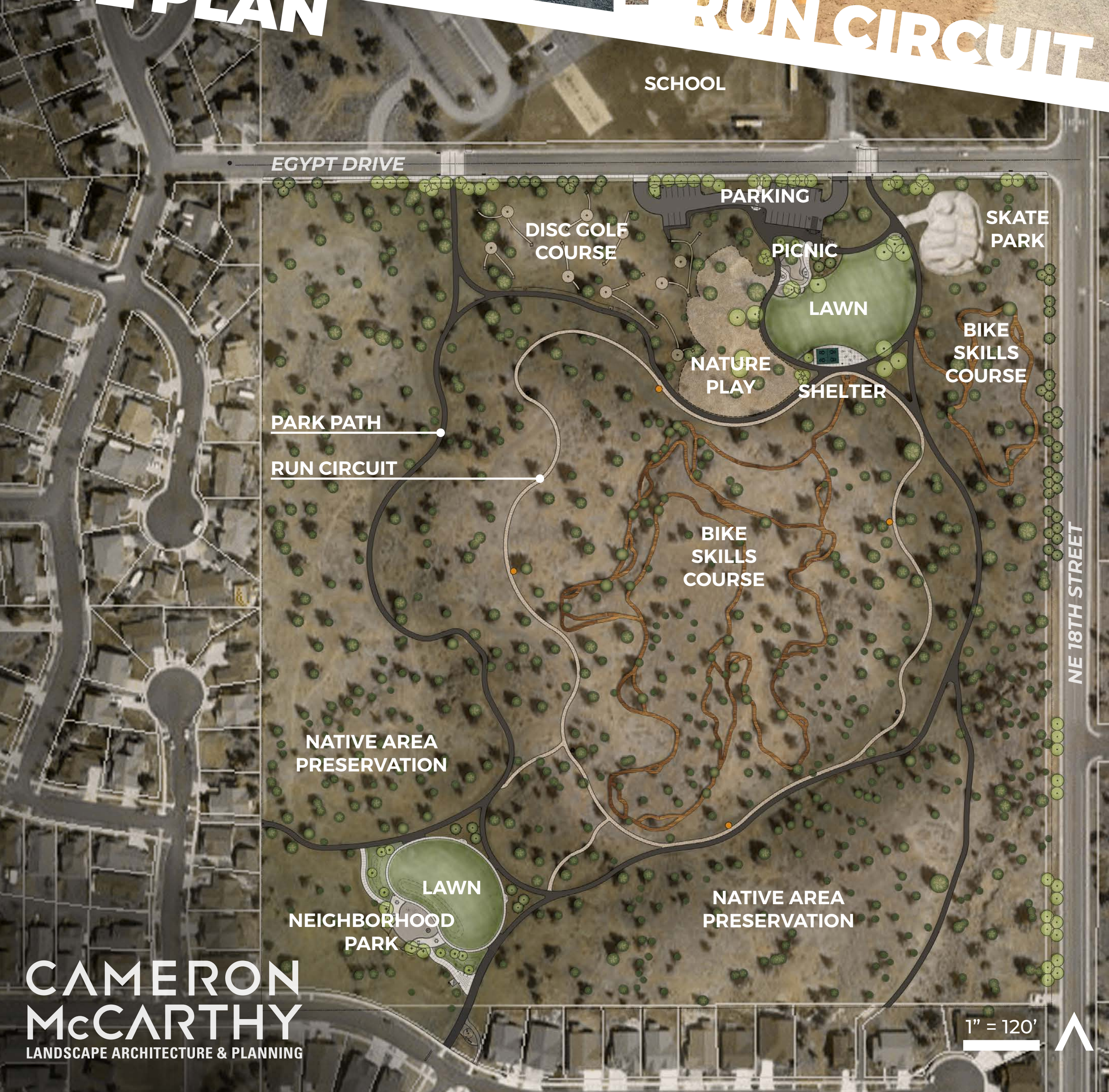
