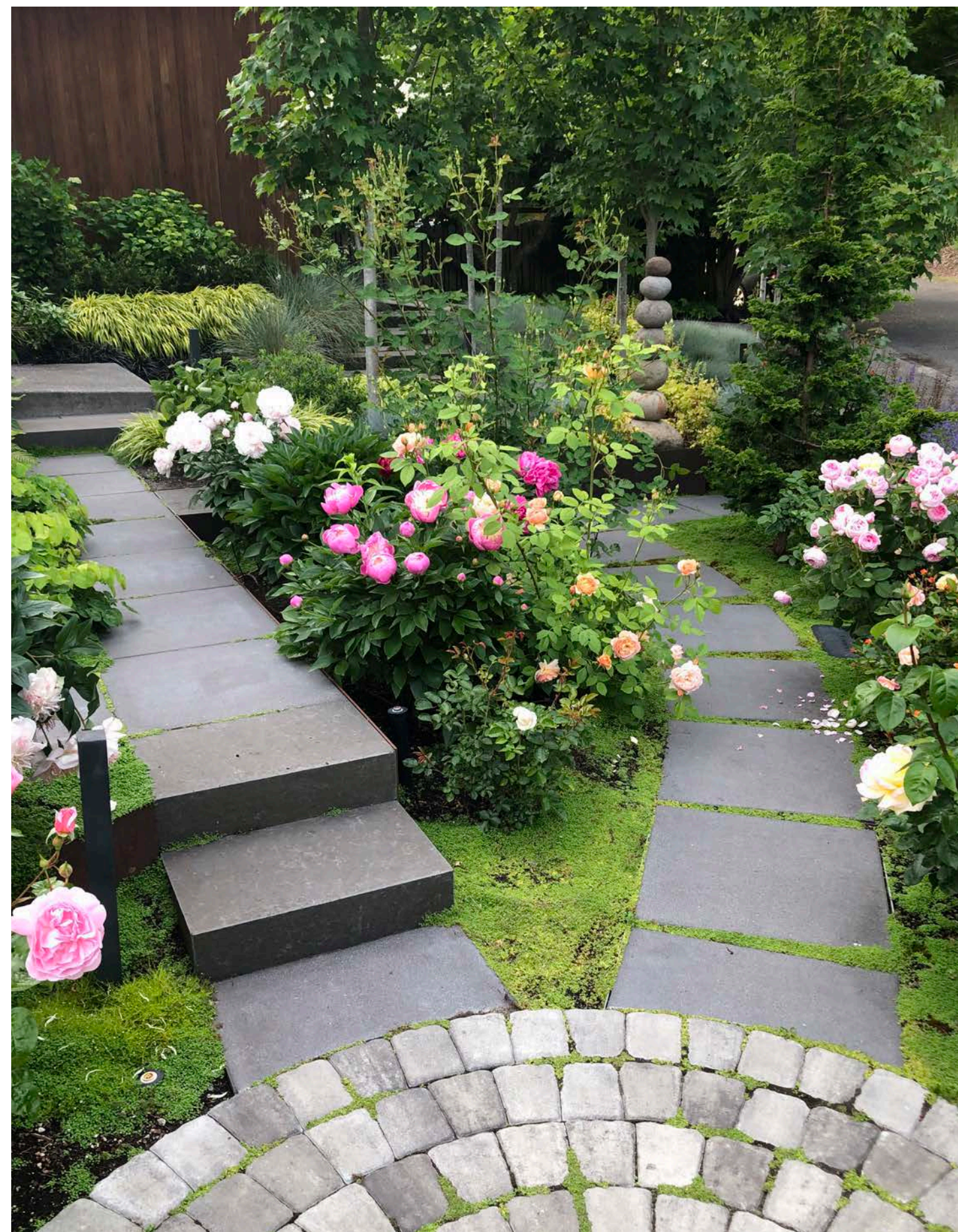
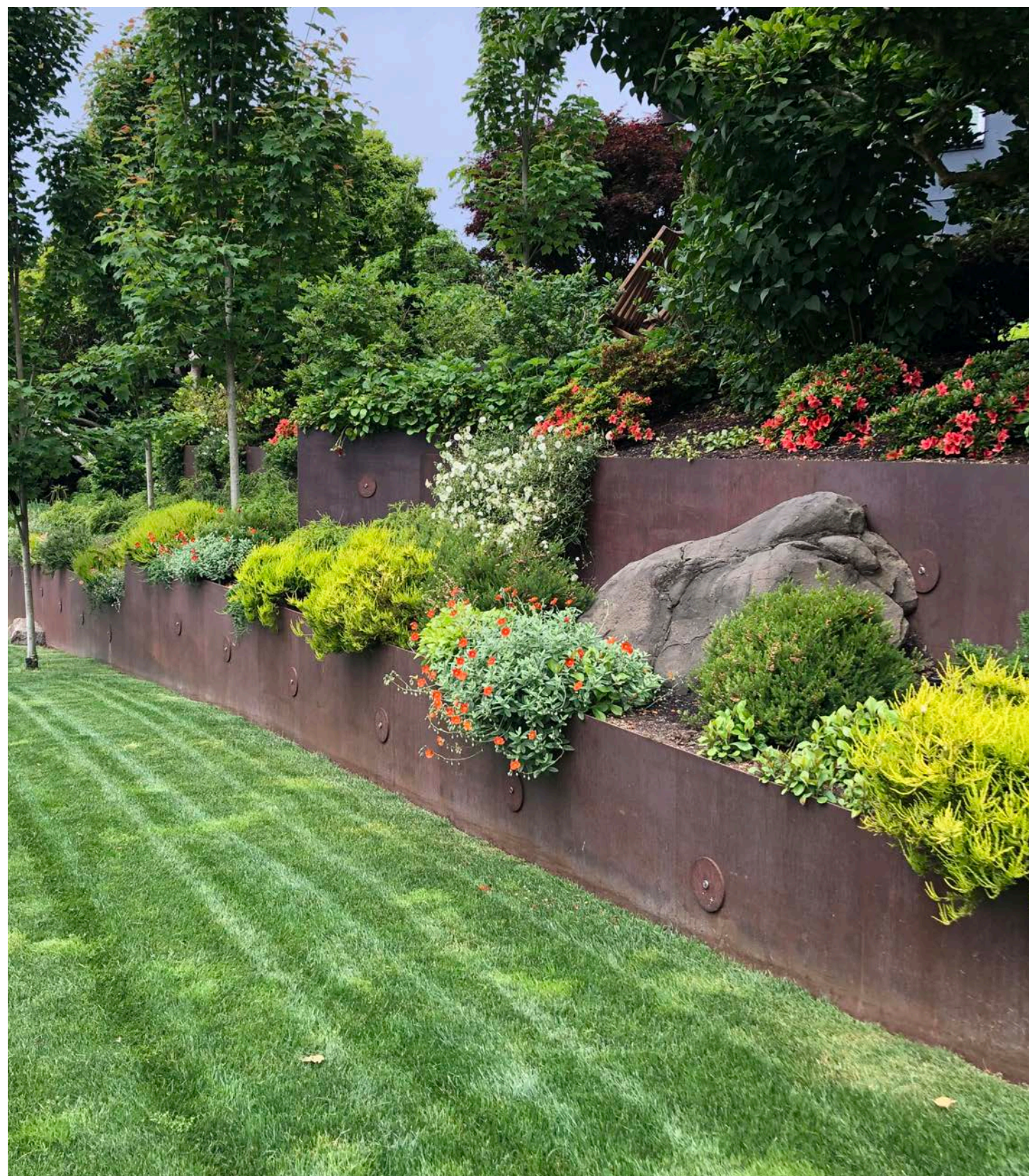


PERMANENT VACATION - The Joseph Garden



Overlooking the Puget Sound, this small walking and vegetable garden **reclaimed** an overgrown and neglected hillside with exquisite, but obstructed views. While the goal of the design was to help **capture** and **accentuate** the views into the Sound, the garden also provides year-round opportunities for vegetable gardening, walking paths, and unique terracing. Existing boulders were incorporated into the Corten steel walls, while newly created terraces provided **extended spaces** for planting and gardening. New paver paths and seating areas create opportunities for **relaxation**, while the planting design provides year-round color and seasonal interest. Upon completion our clients proclaimed that the garden felt like a "Permanent Vacation".
