

### 2019 OSSC Updates



Tomorrow, January 10 from noon to 2:00 – Registration Closed

Samir Mokashi, Principal at Code Unlimited, will be teaching a 2-hour code seminar, "2019 OSSC Updates". The 2019 Oregon Structural Specialty Code is now the building code in Oregon. The course will focus on understanding the changes between the most recent Oregon codes and the 2019 OSSC adoptions, including 2018 IBC codes.

The course is a webinar-format broadcast from the Center for Architecture in Portland (403 NW 11th Ave) to venues in our other section locations, Bend, Eugene, Salem, and Medford (Southern Oregon). 
