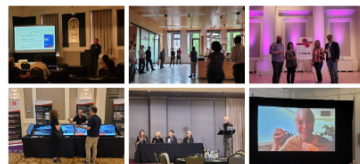
Design with Transformation in Mind

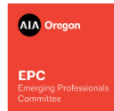
