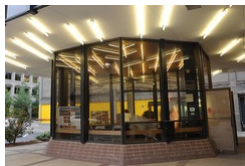


Tour of the Benton County Historical Society Corvallis Museum

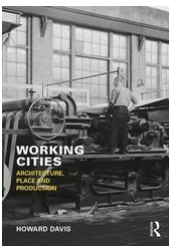
