## Autodesk Offers Free & Extended Access to Cloud Collaboration Products

To better support customers facing the new online reality, Autodesk is announcing a temporary Extended Access Program for several of their flagship cloud collaboration products. Here's how the program will work:

Beginning on March 24, customers can get free access to select Autodesk products and services.

Products and services will include BIM 360 Docs, BIM 360 Design, Fusion 360, Fusion Team, AutoCAD Web and Mobile, and Shotgun – all for commercial use.

Customers can take advantage of this program by visiting the **Expanded Access Program** center on Autodesk.com and following the steps they'd normally take to sign up for an Autodesk product trial on the website.

Customers can take advantage of the Extended Access Program until May 31, 2020. However, they will continue to evaluate a potential expansion of this program as the needs of the customers warrant.

### **Donation of Protective Supplies**

**Franklin Boulevard Transformation - Online Open House** Open Commentary will be available through April 13, 2020.

Planning for this project began in January 2019 with the goal to improve Franklin Boulevard from Alder Street to Interstate-5, including Garden Avenue. The project aims to transform Franklin Boulevard from an auto-focused state highway into a pleasant, multi-modal, urban corridor that is safe for all people, including those who walk, bike, roll, take the bus and drive.

Since then, staff has engaged with the community through multiple public involvement activities, including two workshops, online surveys and meetings with interested parties. Through public input and professional analysis, the three corridor alternatives that were shared in May 2019 have been evaluated and revised into one preferred alternative, which was shared at the Open House on March 10, 2020.
