The City of Eugene wants your feedback on a new housing development—and a model for housing never before seen in Eugene.

In response to a Request for Proposals, the City of Eugene received a proposal for the development of a mixed-income housing project at 1059 Willamette Street. The development team proposes a new mixed-use, mixed-income building with 129 units – 66 of the units would be restricted to households with incomes up to 80% of Area Median Income.
