

Action Now: Accelerating Pathways to Decarbonization April 21 | 8:30am - 5:00pm | 4 Zoom Webinars | 6.5 LU|HSW Available

AIA Seattle has moved their climate summit online, and they invite members from across the country to join them at no cost.

This summit will explore high-impacts actions in policy and practice that make actionable differences in atmospheric carbon over the next five years, including: 1) Reducing embodied carbon in new construction, including both materials and the construction process; 2) Electrification of buildings; and 3) Retrofitting existing buildings. What are the data-driven interventions that will pay the highest dividends immediately, and what will position us to stay on the path to 2030 targets and net-zero 2050? What are the regulatory and financial frameworks necessary to support this scale and urgency?

Attendees may register for as many or as few of the sessions of the four sessions as they wish. Together, these sessions will offer a total of 6.5 LU HSW. Live webinars are limited to 500 participants each. We will also make the recorded program available after the live event, but we will not be able to submit for learning units for later viewing.

Franklin Boulevard Transformation - Online Open House

Open Commentary will be available through April 13, 2020.

Planning for this project began in January 2019 with the goal to improve Franklin Boulevard from Alder Street to Interstate-5, including Garden Avenue. The project aims to transform Franklin Boulevard from an auto-focused state highway into a pleasant, multi-modal, urban corridor that is safe for all people, including those who walk, bike, roll, take the bus and drive.

Since then, staff has engaged with the community through multiple public involvement activities, including two workshops, online surveys and meetings with interested parties. Through public input and professional analysis, the three corridor alternatives that were shared in May 2019 have been evaluated and revised into one preferred alternative, which was shared at the Open House on March 10, 2020.
