Chris White Scholarship for Emerging Professionals



Proceeds from the Golf Tournament are used to fund the Chris White Scholarship for Emerging Professionals - an annual award up to \$1,000 per recipient to one or more selected first-time architecture license candidates in Oregon. The scholarship is intended to help offset financial barriers to licensure often encountered by Emerging Professionals pursuing their first license to practice architecture.

The scholarship remembers Portland architect, Chris White, AIA, who served consistently throughout his career as a mentor to many new and aspiring architects until he passed in 2014 following a battle with cancer.

The Scholarship Application period will begin early this summer.

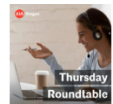
