Springfield Public Hearing on the use of CDBG funds

June 9 | 5:30-6:30pm

The City of Springfield has been allocated \$366.652 in Community Development Block Grant commonism (CDBG-CV3) funds to be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus (CDVU-19). The City of Springfield's proposal for the use of CDBG-CV3 funds is currently available for review. A public comment period on the proposed allocation of funds is currently open and will close on June 9, 2021. A draft is available online HERE.

On Wednesday, June 9, 2021, from 530 – 630pm, the Springleid Community Development Advisory Committee (CDAC) will meet and hold a public hearing on the use of CDBG-CV3 funds. The CDAC will consider all written comments and oral testimony during the public hearing regarding the use of funds, will make a recommendation to the Springleid City Council for allocation of CDBG-CV3 funds.
