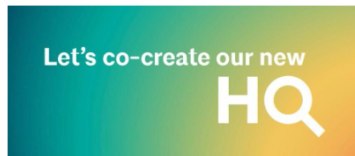

This year's theme: ELEVATE (How do we elevate DEI in design to new heights, what will it take to get us there?). Follow the link below to see our amazing lineup of speakers.

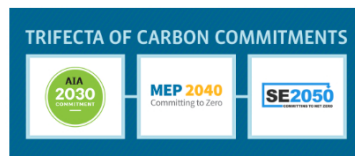
