Chris White/AIA Oregon Scholarship for Emerging **Professionals**

Submission period opens tomorrow, September 1st.

The Chris White/AIA Oregon Scholarship for Emerging Professionals is an annual award up to \$1,000 per recipient to one or more selected first-time architecture license candidates in Oregon through application and committee review.

Eligibility
Applicants must meet the following criteria to be eligible for the scholarship:

- Pursuing their first architecture license.
- Pursuing their first architecture license.
 Enrolled in NCARD's Architectural Experience Program (AXP) or completed. It complete, provide documentation.
 Authorized by NCARD to sit for the ARE.
 An Associate Member of the American Institute of Architects (Assoc. AIA).
 Their employer, if employed, does not provide financial assistance for taking the AREs.

The scholarship is intended to help offset financial barriers to licensure, including those costs associated with education, training and exams often encountered by emerging professionals pursuing their first license to practice architecture.
