

# Howard Smith 1935-2019

Howard Patterson Smith was born in Plattsburg, New York on September 21st 1935, to Festus and Helen Smith. He graduated from Willsboro High School in New York, and after serving in the Army, he graduated from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute (where he was president of the Theta Chi Fraternity) with a degree in Architecture.

In 1961 Howard married Suzanne

Staley and moved to Salem where he began his career as an architect. Howard became a partner in the firm Payne, Settecase and Smith, which later became Settecase, Smith and Doss before morphing into Architects Four, a partnership of Smith, Doss, Bishoprick, and McDermott.

His involvement in the design of the Salem Civic Center complex, the Salem Memorial Hospital, and bringing the Reed Opera House back to life in the early 1980s are examples of some of his work.

Howard also worked on the original Agriculture Building on the Capitol Mall and years later its remodel after being flooded. He worked on a number of projects on the Willamette University campus, and numerous others including Owen's Hall on the OSU campus, Oregon Freeze Dry Foods, the Oregon Capitol Seismic Upgrade, Claggett Creek Middle School, Salem Hospital Outpatient Clinic, and the Chemeketa Viticulture Center.
