

Architecture 2030 issued the 2030 Challenge in 2006, the same year congress passed into law The Energy Efficient Commercial Building Deduction, also known as 179D. This federal tax benefit incentivizes architects and engineers to design and invest in sustainable buildings. This course will provide an overview of the program, cover eligibility and qualification requirements, review case studies, and reference recent court cases that provide encouraging guidance for architecture and engineering firms.
