

OSBAE Appointments

The Oregon State Board of Architect Examiners Board of Directors is comprised of 7 members; 5 of the members are registered architects who have resided in Oregon for at least 5 years and 2 are non-architects, or public members. **Check out their website** to learn more about the OSBAE board members. Board members are selected by the Governor, and terms are 4 years. Board members are typically appointed for two terms.

Traditionally, terms begin and end distinctly for each position. OSBAE is in the process of realigning the beginning of each new member's term to start September 1. This schedule aligns better with annual activities board members are involved in, including attendance at NCARB meetings, and improves onboarding and training for board members.

Help needed for two projects

For the <u>Debre Birhan School</u> in Ethiopia they need a volunteer who can work from existing construction drawings of a composting latrine building to produce one or two 3D exterior color images showing construction materials and details such as brick coursing, as well as the sloping site where the facility will be built. This job is estimated at three to six hours and the work product is needed before the end of October.

For the <u>Q Center</u> renovation in Portland they need one or two volunteers with skills in AutoCAD, Rhino, and/or SketchUp to create 2D and 3D images. Volunteers can expect to contribute a few hours of time per week on an ongoing basis.
