## Recap of AIA Oregon October 18, 2019 Strategic Initiative Planning Retreat

The members of AIA in Oregon began a process focused on improved member services through all parts of the state in 2013. This led to the Report on the Formation of a Single Oregon State Chapter Transition plan in early 2017, and ultimately the realignment to a single chapter – AIA Oregon beginning January 1, 2019. Throughout the process, AIA leadership, through multiple strategic planning retreats developed a series of four strategic initiatives that guide the Board.

The AIA Oregon Board and Leadership Team met in Portland on October 18, 2019 and identified the specific plan for progressing the four strategic initiatives:

- 1. Elevate the Member Experience
- 2. Enhance Professional Development
- 3. Improve our Communities
- 4. Adapt to the Changing Profession

## Call for Presenters: Component "The Big Move" Event at Grassroots 2020

The AIA Board of Directors met in May 2019 and adopted the AIA Design Excellence Framework, a future derivative of the Committee on the Environment's (COTE) Top 10 Framework to guide the AIA's work over the next decade. The framework includes 10 areas of focus in responsible design. Of the ten areas, the AIA Board prioritized three

areas: Economy, Energy, and Equitable Communities as the AIA top focus area for the next three years.

Although you have likely read about the AIA's Big Move Toward Environmental Stewardship, we would like to assemble during Grassroots to discuss the action firms and components are taking to position the architectural profession as key leaders for climate change. This is where you come in. We are seeking storytellers for three

engaging interactive breakout sessions designed to allow you to "tell your story" of what your component or firm is doing to advance the quality of life and protect the public's health, safety and welfare in communities. How are you designing for economy, energy, and equitable communities?
