

Climate Change and Wildfires as Catalysts for New Forms of Architecture and Land Use November 11 | 5:00-6:00pm | 1.5 AIA LU|HSW Available Speaker: Jesse M. Keenan, Ph.D., J.D., LL.M. School of Architecture, Tulane University

This presentation will examine the scope and scale of the Oregon's wildfires through the lens of the state's robust history of growth management and environmental regulation. Through an exploration of normative forms of land use, risk classification, material specification, and risk transfer, the presentation provides a pathway for contextualizing novel forms of architecture that may accommodate future settlement patterns and consumer preferences that are shaped by climate mitigation and adaptation goals.
