

Eugene Area Architects - Focus Group Opportunity Tomorrow!

The City of Eugene and community have actively engaged over the years in planning and visioning efforts to redevelop downtown and along key corridors, and over the last several years we have published the Urban Form Plan and Community Design Handbook as guides to help us visualize what the future could look like. More recently, the City Council directed staff to put together some options for increasing setbacks in commercial areas, and to create an exceptions process. We have many questions, and there are several ways we could implement Council's direction.

City staff has scheduled for a facilitated focus group conversation on November 6. There are two meeting times at 11:00 to 12:30 and 2:00 to 3:30. Your input is requested. The City is interested in the involvement of more architects in the Focus Group 2 that starts at 2:00.

Climate Change and Wildfires as Catalysts for New Forms of Architecture and Land Use November 11 | 5:00-6:00pm | 1.5 AIA LU|HSW Available



Speaker: Jesse M. Keenan, Ph.D., J.D., LL.M.

Jesse is a globally recognized thought leader, whose research focuses on the intersection of climate change adaptation and the built environment, including aspects of design, engineering, regulation, planning and financing. He is an Associate Professor and social

scientist within the faculty of the School of Architecture at Tulane University in New Orleans, Louisiana.

This presentation will examine the scope and scale of the Oregon's wildfires through the lens of the state's robust history of growth management and environmental regulation. Through an exploration of normative forms of land use, risk classification, material specification, and risk transfer, the presentation provides a pathway for contextualizing novel forms of architecture that may accommodate future settlement patterns and consumer preferences that are shaped by climate mitigation and adaptation goals.
