Call for Open Board Positions

Two positions on the AIA Oregon Board will become open on January 1, 2020; Secretary, and AIA Portland Section Director.

The Secretary is a member of the Executive Committee and the position is selected by the Board of Directors. The term of the position is two years. The deadline to submit your letter of interest and resume is 5PM Friday, December 6. See the link below for the selection process for the Secretary.

The Section Director is a member of the Board of Directors and the current position to fill is the Director from the AIA Portland Section. The Section Director serves as the liaison between the local Section and the Board. **Those interested in being nominated should inform AIA Oregon by Friday, December 6.** The Section Director is selected by the Section in the process described at the link below.

In addition, each Section will identify a person to fill the role of Section Director-elect. The Section Director-elect is a newly defined position and intended to support the Section Director by leading the activities of the Section and learning the role of Board Director. It is assumed that the Section Director-elect position will evolve over the course of 2020. The Section Director-elect is selected by the Section in the process described at the link below.



2019 OSSC Updates



Save the date! Friday, January 10, 2020. Registration will be available by November 22.

Samir Mokashi, Principal at Code Unlimited, will be teaching a 2-hour code seminar, "2019 OSSC Updates". The 2019 Oregon Structural Specialty Code went into effect on October 1, 2019 with a 3-month phase is process (either the 2014 OSSC or 2019 OSSC can be used as basis of design for permit submittal). The course will focus on understanding the changes between the most recent Oregon codes and

the 2019 OSSC adoptions, including 2018 IBC codes. Regulations on the issues common to most building types and those that may be commonly misunderstood or misapplied will be covered. This course will explain what changed, why it changed, and how to apply these updates correctly in your projects.

Help needed for two projects

For the <u>Debre Birhan School</u> in Ethiopia they need a volunteer who can work from existing construction drawings of a composting latrine building to produce one or two 3D exterior color images showing construction materials and details such as brick coursing, as well as the sloping site where the facility will be built. This job is estimated at three to six hours and the work product is needed before the end of October.

For the <u>Q Center</u> renovation in Portland they need one or two volunteers with skills in AutoCAD, Rhino, and/or SketchUp to create 2D and 3D images. Volunteers can expect to contribute a few hours of time per week on an ongoing basis.
