### A Pivot for Our New "HO"

Throughout 2023, AIA Oregon and the HQ Task Force have been gathering feedback from members around the state to figure out how to create a headquarters for our organization. We heard from hundreds of you in a survey, at section meetings and at a series of events over the summer. Thank you for participating and sharing your ideas and concerns!

The feedback we received showed us that owning or operating a physical space is less important to you than boosting other core aspects of AIA Oregon. We heard loud and clear, across sections, that your top priorities include connecting



with your peers, advocating for architecture and architects. win your peers, avocating for arcinecture and architects expanding partnerships, celebrating existing spaces, and getting support from AIA Oregon for initiatives in your community. You want reliable, engaging and agile programming – and a responsive organization that meets local needs while building bridges within and across sections



Based on what you shared, we have decided to prioritize member engagement and capacity building in our recommendatio ns instead of physical location(s) for a new physical location(s) for a new headquarters or permanent office space for staff. To ensure there's space for key staff, board and committee meetings, we will pursue partnerships in all sections. We are also coming up with

a new name for this initiative, as "HQ" no longer captures the spirit of what we are doing.

Thank you to the hundreds of you who contributed to the conversations that led AIA Oregon staff, the HQ Task Force and our consultant team to this exciting pivot! We look forward to sharing more details and providing more opportunities for feedback and engagement in early 2024. 


**UO School of Architecture and Environment** Career and Networking Fair 2024 Feb 15 | 11am-3pm | Lawrence Hall
