
**Friday, December 6.** The Section Director is selected by the Section in the process described at the link below.

### 2019 OSSC Updates



#### **Registration now OPEN!**

Samir Mokashi, Principal at Code Unlimited, will be teaching a 2-hour code seminar, "2019 OSSC Updates". The 2019 Oregon Structural Specialty Code went into effect on October 1, 2019 with a 3-month phase is process (either the 2014 OSSC or 2019 OSSC can be used as basis of design for permit submittal).

The course will focus on understanding the changes

between the most recent Oregon codes and the 2019 OSSC adoptions, including 2018 IBC codes. Regulations on the issues common to most building types and those that may be commonly misunderstood or misapplied will be covered. This course will explain what changed, why it changed, and how to apply these updates correctly in your projects.

# Architects Foundation Diversity Advancement Scholarship

Architects Foundation, the philanthropic partner of The American Institute of Architects (AIA), is offering several scholarships for architecture students. Click on the Scholarships to learn more.

The Diversity Advancement Scholorship is offered to Minority High School Students planning to enroll in a NAAB-accredited

architecture degree program, or 2nd year students in a NAAB-accredited architecture degree program. Scholarships may be renewed for up to 5 years (up to a \$20,000 total award-multiple scholarships are available).

#### Payette Sho-Ping Chin Memorial Academic Scholarship

The Payette Sho-Ping Chin Memorial Academic Scholarship is a \$10,000 award supporting a woman studying architecture within a NAAB-accredited bachelor or master's degree program.

#### Yann Weymouth Graduate Scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded each year to an architecture student with a focus on the design intersection of sustainability, resilience, wellness and beauty. The recipient will receive a \$5,000 scholarship, as well as a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to be mentored by Yann Weymouth.

#### a/e ProNet David W. Lakamp AIA Scholarship

The a/e ProNet David W. Lakamp scholarship is awarded annually to two students who demonstrate a strong interest in practice and risk management in the field of architecture. Each student receives a \$5,000 award.

The application period for all these scholarships is now open through January 17, 2020.

#### Architects Without Borders - Call for Volunteers

Help needed for two projects

For the <u>Debre Birhan School</u> in Ethiopia they need a volunteer who can work from existing construction drawings of a composting latrine building to produce one or two 3D exterior color images showing construction materials and details such as brick coursing, as well as the sloping site where the facility will be built. This job is estimated at three to six hours and the work product is needed before the end of October.

For the <u>Q Center</u> renovation in Portland they need one or two volunteers with skills in AutoCAD, Rhino, and/or SketchUp to create 2D and 3D images. Volunteers can expect to contribute a few hours of time per week on an ongoing basis.
